

City police hunt pair of thieves

City police are looking for a young man who held up a grocery store Monday and left with \$31.50.

Mrs. Nora Bakalinsky, 55, was working in the back of Bakalinsky's Grocery, 543 Logan Ave., at 7:55 p.m. when the man came in the door.

He intimated he had a gun in his pocket, demanded Mrs. Bakalinsky to open the cash register and fled west on Logan with \$31.50.

She told police he was about 18 or 19 years old, five feet, five inches, slim, fair complexion, blonde brush cut and spoke good English. He was last noticed wearing a yellow leather jacket.

An hour earlier, a 40-year-old Winnipeg woman, Frances Ramsay, of Ste. 11, 214 Furby St., told police her purse was snatched.

She said she was waiting on Furby about 7 p.m. when a young man approached her, lunged at her purse, tearing the strap off.

Mrs. Ramsay said the purse and contents are worth \$145
